We are happy to report that the State Board of Education has approved the [Ohio Dyslexia Guidebook](#) which was proposed in January 2022 as part of HB 436 legislation.

- The Guidebook contains best practices and methods for universal screening, intervention, and remediation for children with dyslexia or children displaying dyslexic characteristics and tendencies.
- Districts and schools should use the guidebook to access critical information for the successful implementation of Ohio's dyslexia support laws.

It was an uphill climb but now that it is approved we are hopeful about the best practices it puts in place.
