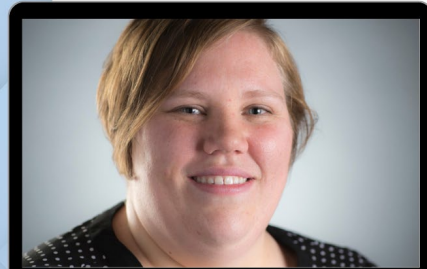
Objectives:
